MASS SCHEDULE:

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM IS CELEBRATED ON THE 4TH SUNDAY OF EVERY MONTH (NO BAPTISM DURING LENT). BAPTIS-MAL PREPARATION CLASS IS HELD ON THE THURSDAY BEFORE BAPTISM AT 6PM. THIS CLASS IS MANDATORY. PLEASE REGISTER AT LEAST ONE WEEK IN ADVANCE OF THE CLASS THROUGH THE RELIGIOUS EDUCATION OFFICE OR THE PARISH OFFICE.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION IS CELEBRATED ONE HALF HOUR BEFORE EACH WEEKEND MASS.

Marriage Law of the Diocese requires a six month preparation period before marriage. Couples must attend a pre-marriage seminar. In this Diocese there are no evening weddings on Saturday It is necessary to see the priest before setting a date.

- 1 Adoration, Praise and Worship (APW) will be held here at St. Francis from 3:00 pm until 4:30 pm. Mass following APW.
- 2 The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) The Feast of Corpus Christi, festival of the Roman Catholic Church in honor of the real presence of the body (*corpus*) of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. A movable observance, it is observed on the Thursday (or, in some countries, the Sunday) after Trinity Sunday and is a holy day of obligation in many countries.
- 7 The Historic National Eucharistic Revival Pilgrimage to Stop in Baton Rouge- On June 7, 2024, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will be stopping in Baton Rouge on its route to the National Eucharistic Congress taking place on July 17-21, 2024, in Indianapolis, Indiana. The day will begin with 8 a.m. mass at Sacred Heart of Jesus Catholic Church in Baton Rouge followed by a 1.5-mile Eucharistic Procession beginning at 9:30 a.m. from Sacred Heart to St. Joseph Cathedral. At the Cathedral, pilgrims will have the opportunity to hear from Bishop Michael G. Duca, learn more about the call to service in our Baton Rouge community eat lunch and hear testimonies from the National Eucharistic Pilgrims from 10:20 a.m. -1:30 p.m. At 2 p.m., a Eucharistic Prayer Service will begin at Christ the King Catholic Church and Student Center on LSU's campus featuring Eucharistic Adoration, praise and worship, prayer ministries and confession with priests from throughout the diocese. The event will end at 4 p.m. All events during the Baton Rouge stop of the Pilgrimage are free and open to the public. Due to the day's schedule, all pilgrims will be responsible for their own transportation to and from the various events around Baton Rouge. Local organizers recommend that pilgrims carpool or utilize transportation apps, especially if they are attending the Eucharistic Procession from Sacred Heart to the Cathedral.


